

Boys & Girls Club of Corvallis Dress Codes

All areas of the Club (except high school rooms):

Any attire which promotes the use of drugs, alcohol, gang membership, violence or is derogatory towards any person/group is contrary to the developmental goals of our Club.

Examples of unacceptable dress include, but are not limited to:

- Shirts or items using racial, ethnic, and/or gender put-downs
- Shirts or items portraying inappropriate language or symbols
- Sagging pants – Pants need to be at the hipbones or higher
- Ripped or torn clothing
- Pants/shorts rolled down over the top few inches exposing skin below the shirt line
- Shorts/ skirts shorter than fingertips when arms are relaxed at one's sides or are shorter than mid-thigh
- Clothing that reveals undergarments (bras, briefs, boxers)
- See-through mesh type clothing
- Chains that hang off clothing
- Sunglasses worn inside the building
- Gloves worn inside the building
- Shirts that don't cover the torso (no bare midriffs)
- Spaghetti straps (straps must be a minimum of 1-1/2 inches wide)
- Immodest or revealing low cut/v-neck shirts exposing chest cleavage
- Gang-related attire, including bandanas
- Bare feet or unsafe shoes
- Slippers without hard soles

High School rooms only:

The following are guidelines for this area:

- Dress and grooming shall be clean and in keeping with health and sanitary practices. Articles of clothing and accessories may not create a safety hazard to the individual Club members or others. This also applies to Club members participating in special activities.
- Gang dress-Dress that is associated with gangs and/or gang affiliation is not allowed.
- Articles of clothing that display weapons, advertise or promote the use of alcohol, tobacco or drug products, or that display vulgar or sexually suggestive words or pictures are not permitted in the Club.
- Any underwear or undergarment may not be visible.
- Halter-tops and or strapless or backless tops are not allowed.
- Tops showing too much cleavage are inappropriate for the Club.
- Midriffs should be covered.
- Shorts will be as long as the individuals fingers when arms are held down at their sides.
- Neither masks nor complete face paint allowed at Club or Club activities.
