Organization Mission

Position Summary:

The Teen Center intern reports directly to the High School Director. Interns are responsible for developing activities, researching community resources for outcome driven activities and facilitating these activities with members. Additionally, this individual will supervise club members in defined activity spaces, keep general areas clean and organized and implement positive youth development strategies and practices. This team member will work to support the Program Director with achieving the Teen Center's goals and outcomes.

Responsibilities

- Prepare Youth for Success
 - Promote and stimulate activity participation.
 - Provide guidance and role modeling to members.
 - Maintain a clean, safe and positive environment for youth development.
- Program Development and Implementation
 - Develop and implement exciting age appropriate activities geared towards healthy lifestyles
 - Research and manage member interests' in non-academic activities: book clubs, movie clubs, chess club... etc.
 - Provide planning and execution of various special events such as: volunteering in the community, sporting activities and in-club activities.
 - Monitor and assess activities and services to ensure safety of members and quality of activity. This includes tracking member attendance, preparation of weekly reports, and weekly meetings with High School Director.

- Supervision
 - Enforce behavioral club standards and implement disciplinary action in a positive and affirming manner.
 - Communicate disciplinary issues with other staff and parents to ensure a holistic youth development approach.
