- 2) Safety Town volunteer applicants that are not currently members may register for a membership.
- 3) Active members will receive first consideration for open positions. Youth that are currently invested in the Club and its programs will have first opportunity to engage in service opportunities at the Club.
- 4) This program has been designed primarily for middle school students, as their ability to attain similar service opportunities is often limited.
- 5) Returning Safety Town volunteers who have received positive feedback from staff and interns will have their experience factored into selection decisions.
