Instructions:

1. Determine family size - this is everyone living in the same household.
2. Add together all family income - income from all sources for everyone in the household.
3. Starting on the far left - find your family size number - stay on that row and move to the first box (130% of poverty level)
4. If your income - annual, monthly, weekly, etc. is equal to or less than the income amount in the first group of boxes, you are eligible for the \$25 per month fee.
5. If your income is greater than the income amount in the first set of values, then move to the next set of values (185% of poverty level) and check again. If your income is equal to or less than these values, you are eligible for the \$35 per month fee.
6. If your income is greater than the income amount in the second set of values, then move to the next set of values (300% of poverty level) and check again. If your income is equal to or less than these values, you are eligible for the \$100 per month fee.
7. If your income is greater than the income amount in the third set of values, then move to the next set of values (350% of poverty level) and check again. If your income is equal to or less than these values, you are eligible for the \$175 per month fee.
8. If your income is greater than the income amount in the fourth set of values, then your fee is \$285 per month.
