

# Boys & Girls Club of Corvallis Dress Code

## DRESS AND ATTIRE EXPECTATIONS

### **Allowable Dress & Attire:**

- Club Members must wear clothing including both a shirt with pants, shorts, or skirt, or the equivalent and shoes.
- Clothing must have fabric in the front and on the sides.
- Clothing must cover undergarments (waistbands and bra straps excluded).
- Fabric covering all private parts must not be see-through.
- Hats and other headwear must allow the face to be visible and not interfere with the line of sight to any Club Member or staff. Hoodies must allow the Club Members face and ears to be visible to staff.
- Clothing and shoes must be suitable for all Clubhouse activities including gym and art, and other activities where unique hazards exist.
- Specialized activities may require specialized attire, such as closed toed shoes or paint smocks.

### **Non-Allowable Dress & Attire:**

- Clothing may not depict, advertise or advocate the use of alcohol, tobacco, marijuana or other controlled substances.
- Clothing may not depict pornography, nudity or sexual acts.
- Clothing may not use or depict hate speech targeting groups based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, religious affiliation or any other protected groups.
- Clothing must not threaten the health or safety of any other Club Member or staff.
- Clothing may not display profanity.
